

Smoke Alarm Replacement



The National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) strongly recommends the replacement of home smoke alarms every 10 years. Smoke alarms become less reliable with time, primarily due to aging of their electronic components, making them susceptible to nuisance false alarms.

All homes in SCLH have hardwired smoke alarms because they are required by California law. Neighbors InDeed will install your new alarms once you have them on hand*. All smoke alarms must be replaced at the same time.

*Excludes homes with 12 ft. or higher ceilings.

Recommended replacement unit:

First Alert SMI100-AC with Alkaline 9-volt battery

Note: We do not recommend 10-year batteries for smoke alarms.

First Alert SMI100-AC alarms are available locally at Lowes or online.
